Graduating Students Present Passionate Graduation Theses

The graduation thesis examinations for students graduating this semester have been conducted across all departments.

The graduation thesis examinations were held in two stages: the first review and the second review. Students took the time to present their research findings and projects, which they had diligently prepared for the past year, either individually or in teams.

The current status of graduation thesis presentations is as follows: 12 from the Department of Information and Communication Engineering, 7 from the Department of Medical Engineering, 4 from the Department of Food and Nutrition, 5 from the Department of English Language, 2 from the Department of Korean Language, 1 from the Department of Business Administration, 14 from the Department of Multimedia, and 28 from the Department of Computer Science, totaling 73 theses presented. This is an increase in the number of theses compared to last year, highlighting the academic passion and effort of the students.

The faculty examiners from each department carefully listened to the students' presentations and evaluated the completeness of the theses and their research capabilities through in-depth question-and-answer sessions. Despite their nervousness, the students confidently explained their research findings and engaged in the examinations.

This graduation thesis examination marks an important gateway for students as they complete their undergraduate studies and move on to society. We support the graduating students who will shine in their respective fields in the future.

Student Wins 3rd Place at Academic Conference

Our university students have achieved excellent results at the student academic conference jointly hosted by the School of Energy Engineering at the Mongolian University of Science and Technology and Suben-uul LLC.

The academic conference was held under the theme of "The Future of Medical Engineering." Two students from our university participated: Ganchimeg, a 4th-year student from the Department of Mechanical Engineering, presented on "Water Treatment System of Hemodialysis Machines Used in Mongolia," and Mendsaikhan, a 4th-year student from the Department of Information Technology, presented on "Requirements and Modeling of an Electronic Platform to Improve Blood Supply in Mongolia" under the guidance of Professor Uyanga from the Department of Information and Communication Engineering.

In particular, **Mendsaikhan was recognized for his outstanding research content and presentation skills, earning the honorable 3rd place.**

A total of 17 papers were presented at the conference, with participation from four universities including our university, the Mongolian National University of Science and Technology, the Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences, and Etugen University, resulting in fierce competition. Our university student's achievement of 3rd place amidst this competition is particularly significant.

This achievement was made possible by the students' continuous efforts and the passionate guidance of their supervising professor. It is expected that our university students will continue to make outstanding achievements in various academic fields in the future.



Selected for the Taekwondo Overseas Promotion Project for the 6th Consecutive Year
