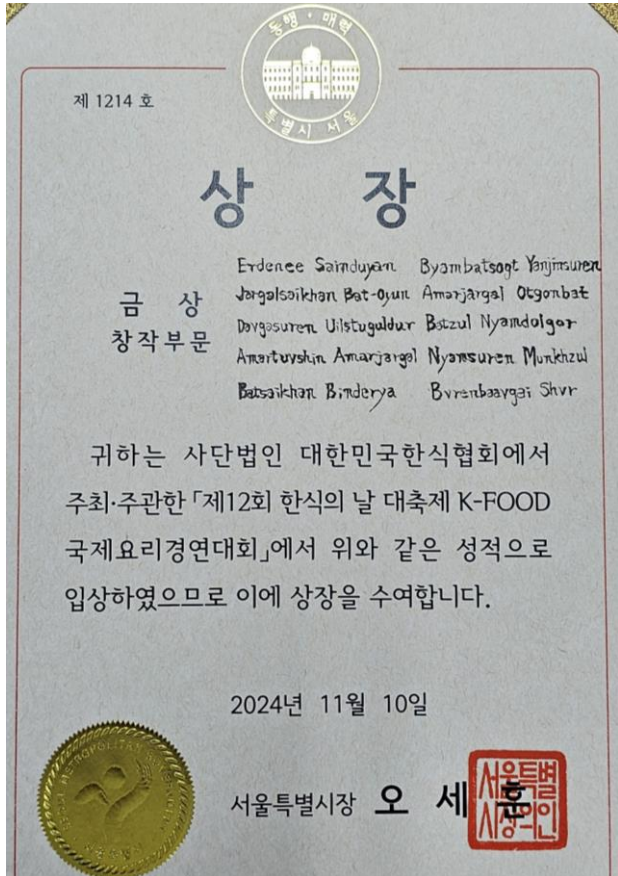
Department of Food and Nutrition Wins Gold at International Culinary Management Competition

Huree University submitted its application for "Ikh" status to the Mongolian Ministry of Education on December 25. This move comes as part of a nationwide policy to restructure higher education institutions into two categories: "Ikh" (university) and "College."

To qualify for "Ikh" status, Huree University has been strengthening its educational and research capacities, infrastructure, and academic achievements. The submission of this application marks an important step toward becoming a full-fledged university.

A school representative stated, "The inspection results will be released in January, with a final decision expected in February. If approved, this will significantly enhance our ability to contribute to the development of education in Mongolia."

Should the "Ikh" status be granted, Huree University is poised to exert greater influence in Mongolia's higher education landscape and provide an even higher quality learning environment for its students.
