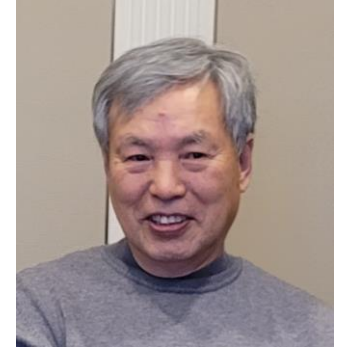

Professor Kangkyu Jin Joins the Department of Information Technology

Our University is pleased to announce that Professor **Kangkyu Jin** joined the Department of Information Technology on February 9.



Professor Jin retired from Korea Maritime and Ocean University in 2019, but has continued his academic work actively since then. Over the past six years, he has been engaged in teaching and research at Adama Science and Technology University in Ethiopia, where he supervised graduate students in both master's and doctoral programs.

His primary research areas include MATLAB and Graphics, Optimization techniques such as Genetic Algorithms and Particle Swarm Optimization (PSO), as well as Simulation and Animation of Dynamic Systems. Through his active research in these fields, Professor Jin has continued to publish numerous academic papers and remains actively involved in scholarly activities.

The university expects that Professor Jin's extensive academic experience and ongoing research will make a significant contribution to strengthening the research capacity of the university. His appointment is anticipated to serve as an important foundation for the university as it continues its efforts to grow into a globally recognized research-oriented institution.
