\$60,000 Donation for Gymnasium Flooring Speeds Up Completion

Vice Chairman Seo Chang-Woo Makes a Significant Contribution to University Development

The construction of Huree University's gymnasium has reached a crucial milestone. On January 3, Vice Chairman Seo Chang-Woo donated \$60,000 to fund the installation of the gymnasium's flooring, bringing the long-awaited project closer to completion.



The gymnasium has been one of Huree University's key development projects and an essential requirement for achieving "Ikh" status under the Mongolian Ministry of Education's accreditation process. Given Mongolia's harsh winters, where temperatures often drop below -30°C, indoor sports facilities are crucial for students' health and well-being. 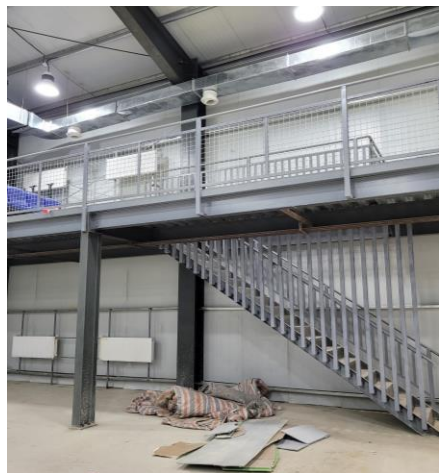
