Dr. Erdenbayar, Graduate of Huree University, Achieves Prestigious Appointment as Assistant Professor at Yonsei University

Dr. Erdenbayar, an alumnus of Huree University's Department of Computer Science (Class of 2002), has been appointed as an Assistant Professor in the Department of AI Semiconductor Engineering at Yonsei University, a distinguished private university in South Korea, effective February 2025. This marks a historic moment as Dr. Erdenbayar is the first graduate of Huree University to be appointed as a university professor in Korea.



Following his graduation from Huree University, Dr. Erdenbayar earned a Master's degree in Electronic Engineering from Inha University. He then returned to his alma mater, Huree University, where he dedicated two years to nurturing future talent as a professor in the Department of Medical Engineering. Driven by his passion for academic research, he pursued further studies at Yonsei University, culminating in a Ph.D. in Medical Engineering. Subsequently, he served as a Research Professor at Yonsei University before achieving his well-deserved appointment as Assistant Professor.

This news of his appointment has brought immense joy and pride to the entire Huree University community. Dr. Erdenbayar expressed his deep gratitude to former President Kim Young-kwon, who established the University, President Chung Soon-Hoon, who is committed to the university's development, and the faculty of the Department of Computer Science who mentored him. Professor Otgonbaatar Achieves Landmark Publication of First SCI Paper by Mongolian Professor

Professor Otgonbaatar of our university's Department of Information and Communication has achieved a remarkable feat with the acceptance of his paper, "Hybrid Network Architecture and Design of Terrestrial and Satellite Network, Its Reliability for Mongolia," for publication in the prestigious international journal, the Journal of Electrical Engineering & Technology (Springer, SCIE, Impact Factor: 1.6).



This publication is particularly significant as it marks the first SCI (Science Citation Index) indexed paper by a Mongolian faculty member since our university's establishment. This achievement not only underscores our university's research capabilities on the global stage but also is expected to positively impact the university's research evaluation in the future.

Professor Otgonbaatar's research, focusing on the design and reliability of a hybrid network architecture combining Mongolia's terrestrial and satellite networks, is recognized for its significant contribution to the field.

The success of this SCI paper is also anticipated to positively influence Professor Otgonbaatar's pursuit of his doctoral degree. Currently enrolled in a doctoral program at the Mongolian University of Science and Technology, he is expected to successfully complete his doctoral dissertation defense this semester, building on the strength of this published work.

Architecture Graduate Uyanga Achieves Doctoral Degree from University of Seoul

Uyanga, a 2017 graduate of our university's Department of Architecture, has earned a prestigious doctoral degree from the University of Seoul this past February. Dr. Uyanga was awarded her Ph.D. in Architecture for her in-depth dissertation, "Characteristics of Social Infrastructure Distribution and Socioeconomic Characteristics by Residential Area Types in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia."

Dr. Uyanga expressed her gratitude, reflecting on her undergraduate years at her alma mater, Huree University. She stated, "The time spent at Huree University was not just a learning process but a crucial foundation for my growth as a researcher."
